Activities of PTA for the year 2018-19

Publication grant/ assistance for international travel to students

The PTA Executive committee held on 3rd September 2018 has decided to construct houses for flood hit areas of Kerala with financial support from the TKMCE Alumni Association. It was also decided to use the Bank account of the PTA for the Back to Home project. The college has completed the construction of nine houses and the construction of three houses is progressing. At Munroe Island, the project has completed three houses and handed over the keys to the beneficiaries. Keys of two houses at Pandalam, two at Budhanoor, one at Peroor Thattarkonam and one at Thrikkovilvattom were handed over to the beneficiaries. The construction of one house at Vellimon, one at Pandarakkulam and another at Champakkulam is going on.

The project has used pre-fabricated pre-stressed technology for the soil type specific construction of houses in all the cases. The area ranges between 500 and 550 sq.feet. The average cost per house is approximately 7.5 lakhs
