About the College

Thangal Kunju Musaliar College of Engineering is one of the premier institutions of national importance in higher education and industrial research. It was established in 1958 as the first grant-in-aid engineering college in the state of Kerala by the late Janab A Thangal Kunju Musaliar, an industrialist, philanthropist and a great visionary.
