

9. INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION POLICY

Statement

The International Research cell assists researchers in identifying the current research thrust areas around the globe and generate new or theoretical or/and experimental knowledge by collaborating with other academic disciplines, Indian and Foreign universities, research centres and Industry.

Objectives

- Joint educational, training and /or research /project activities
- Exchange of invitations to scholars (faculty, research professional and graduate students)
 for lectures, visits and sharing of experience
- Exchange of invitations to scholars for participation in conferences, symposia and seminars
- Exchange of information in the fields of interest to both parties
- Exchange of faculty, research personnel and graduate and undergraduate students for study and research

Scope

The policy shall serve as an overall framework within which international research activities may be carried out. The policy is applicable to all departments of TKM College of Engineering.

Procedure

- Faculty members are expected to undertake collaborative research, leading to quality publications and presentations in international conferences of repute and generation of intellectual property with a strong potential of commercialization.
- The quality of research output shall be assessed on the established yardsticks such as Impact factor and other parameters.
- The implementation and upgrading of Research Policy shall be carried out by the

coordinator of the International Research Collaboration Cell, in consultation with the council members under the direct supervision of the Principal.
